Maple Reinders Constructors, a Top 50 Employer, Leads Construction of Expanded Terminal for Porter Airlines

Toronto, Ontario – April 28, 2009 - Maple Reinders Constructors has undertaken the challenge of leading the construction of a \$45 million expansion of Porter Airlines' terminal at Toronto City Centre Airport. Maple Reinders has commenced building a new 150,000 square foot passenger terminal which will be capable of handling over 1 million passengers annually by its completion in Spring 2010. The new terminal includes a mix of retail, food services, duty-free, car rentals and other services. This critical job creation announcement in tough economic times was made yesterday at a ceremony on Toronto Island and attended by The Hon. Jim Flaherty, Minister of Finance and Minister Responsible for the GTA; The Hon. John Baird, Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities; The Hon. Michael Bryant, Minister of Economic Development for Ontario; Mark McQueen, Chair of the Toronto Port Authority, Porter Airlines executives, as well as executives from Maple Reinders Constructors.

The project will generate 300 construction jobs by the time it is fully completed in 2010, with Porter Airlines expected to increase their employees from the current 600 to approximately 1,000 employees.
